

COVID-19 Information

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Preliminary Information Release

This document has been provided for the purpose of sharing relevant information as it comes to hand. As such, the information here is not complete. Please consider this preliminary information prior to more detail becoming available.

Contract Training Exemptions:

In acknowledgement of the difficulties in accessing formal training programs in the COVID-19 environment, NAFC has approved that:

- where a NAFC contract requires Flight Crew, Crewpersons and other key Personnel involved with the delivery of the Services to have undertaken refresher training in Team Resource Management and human factors within the three years prior delivering Services; and
- where a contract requires that Flight Crew and Crewpersons have undergone human factors training in the recognition and avoidance of flight obstacles at low level;

then the time window for compliance with the refresher training requirements will be automatically extended for all contracts to 30 June 2021. It is recommended that for those persons approaching the three year limits the relevant Operators undertake suitable internal refresher training.

In most NAFC contracts the relevant provisions are in Schedule 4 para 1, however this may vary with individual contracts.
